This training was a delayed event, which was planned to take place in March 2020 but was postponed due to the pandemic. Between March 2020 and October 2022, the partner which was originally planned to host this event (Bielefeld University) left the consortium and was replaced by Paderborn University (the host of the event reported in this document). This change did not change the financial rules of its organisation.

Goals

This event took the form of a seminar during which we exchanged good practices by means of presentations, discussion and practical workshops concerning aspects related to teaching multilingual classes, including findings from studies of real-life cases and mock workshops. These workshops involved evidence from study visits at schools that partners conducted prior to the event. The discussions also related to EU documents relevant to multilingualism.



The end result of this event was a synthesis of knowledge about teaching multilingual classes.

Additionally, we participated in a session titled: *Genre-based scaffolding and (bi)literacy across the subject areas* led by an external expert: Dr. Erkan Gürsoy, University of Duisburg-Essen, Germany, Associate Professor in Teaching German as a Second Language across school subjects, especially in sciences.



All partners sent in-person teams (UL, CTI, AMU, ION, BREM, ODN) and also some team members participated online, with Paderborn University participants hosting this TPM. The meeting progressed as planned.
